## NOTES

1. The Project Account Identifier can be **up to 8 characters long**.

For Member State projects the **first 2 characters** should be the country code for that country. (e.g. SE for Sweden, DE for Germany).

For Special projects the **first 4 characters** should be SP followed by the country code from the country where the Project is proposed. (e.g. a French Special Project would begin SPFR)

2. Article 2 (f) of the ECMWF convention states

*"The objectives of the centre shall be:*

*(f) to make available to the meteorological offices of the Member States for their research, priority being given to the field of numerical weather forecasting, a sufficient proportion of its computing capacity, such proportion being determined by the Council;"*

3.
